A new book featuring the early life of John Diefenbaker kicks off an ambitious new series on the prime ministers by Fireside Publishing House. *The Mystery of the Moonlight Murder: An Early Adventure of John Diefenbaker*, written by Roderick Bennis, is geared to ages 10-14. The historical fiction novel is set 100 years ago near Borden, Saskatchewan, at the Diefenbaker homestead.

John Diefenbaker's early life was fascinating, growing up on a homestead in rural Saskatchewan."

While the storyline is fiction, the environment in which young John Diefenbaker lived, his family life dynamics, his belief system and the foreshadowing of his professional life are all real. The book series aims to make a contribution to Canadian history and civics in general.
